RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Resolved:

That a Conservation Commission be and the same is hereby established under provisions of Sec. 7-131a and Sec. 7-131b General Statutes for development and conservation of natural resources including resources within the Town of Harwinton. Such commission shall consist of five members who shall be appointed by the authority designated by Sec. 131a General Statutes to serve as hereinafter provided:

One member who shall hold office for five years; one who shall hold office for four years; one who shall hold office for three years; one who shall hold office for two years and one who shall hold office for one year from the third Monday of November 1963. The appointing authority, within one month prior to the third Monday of November of each year beginning in 1964 shall appoint one member to serve for a term of five years from the third Monday of November of the year of his appointment. Members of this commission are to be appointed by the First Selectman. (Sec. 131a General Statutes)
