ORDINANCE CONCERNING BUILDING INSPECTOR AND FEES UNDER BASICBUILDING CODE

Section 1. The building inspector shall perform all of the duties and exercise all of the powers of the building authority as set forth in the Basic Building Code heretofore adopted.

Section 2. The building inspector shall hold office until the second Monday of November 1969. The Selectmen shall after each biennial election and prior to the 2nd Monday of November thereafter appoint a building inspector to hold office until his successor shall have been appointed and qualified.

Section 3. The building inspector shall collect fees of \$4 per \$1000, or fraction thereof, of estimated cost of building, alteration, moving, demolition, and signs. He shall comply with Section 118 and other sections of the building code relating to fees and other conduct of his office.

Section 4. The Selectmen shall compensate the Building Inspector by making payment to him monthly an amount equal to the fees received during the previous calendar month. Said compensation shall be in full for his services and for any expenses which he may incur in the conduct of his office.
