ORDINANCE CONCERNING APPOINTMENT OF CONSTABLES

Pursuant to Section 9-185 of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Board of Selectmen shall have the authority and discretion to appoint a constable or constables in lieu of constables to have been elected under Section 9-200. Each appointment shall be on terms satisfactory to the Board of Selectmen, except that the period for which said constable or constables shall be appointed shall not exceed that period for which said constable or constables would have been eligible to serve if elected. The purpose of this ordinance is to confer upon the Board of Selectmen the sole power to fill the office of constable and during the period that this ordinance is in effect, no constable shall be elected.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be 15 days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Harwinton.
