ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

(as amended)

The Town accepts the provisions of Public Act No. 245 of the General Assembly of 1965 and established an Economic Development Commission for the promotion and development of the economic resources of the Town of Harwinton. Said commission shall consist of seven members who shall be appointed by the Board of Selectmen.

Within 90 days from the adoption of this amendment, the appointing authority shall appoint, in addition to the present five members of the commission currently holding five-year terms, two additional members to the commission, one to hold office until the first Tuesday of December, 1980, and one to hold office until the first Tuesday of December 1982.

On or within 30 days subsequent to the first Tuesday of December of each year beginning in 1978, the appointing authority shall appoint for terms of five years members to succeed those whose terms expire. This ordinance as amended shall become effective 15 days after publication in a newspaper having circulation in the Town.
