

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE USE OF PUBLIC LANDS

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN OF HARWINTON:

1. As used herein, "public lands" means all property located within the Town of Harwinton which is owned or regulated by the Town of Harwinton, the Harwinton Conservation Commission, The Harwinton Recreation Commission, or the Regional 10 Board of Education. All public lands shall be open to the public only from sunrise to one hour after sunset daily, or for attendance at authorized events.
2. Alcoholic beverages may neither be possessed nor consumed on public lands.
3. Motor vehicles shall park on public lands only in areas specially designated for that use.
4. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$100 for each offense.
5. Harwinton Ordinance Number 49 passed October 23, 1979 and effective November 16, 1979, is hereby repealed.
6. This Ordinance is to take effect at the time provided by Section 7-157 of the Connecticut General Statutes.
